## SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH ALACHUA COUNTY COALITION FOR THE HOMELESS AND HUNGRY, INC., NO. 14004

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT ("Amendment") is made by and between Alachua County, Florida, a political subdivision and charter county of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (the "County") and Alachua County Coalition for the Homeless and Hungry, Inc. doing business as GRACE Marketplace, a Florida not-for-profit corporation which is authorized to do business in the State of Florida ("Agency"), who are collectively referred to as the "Parties".

#### WITNESSETH:

**WHEREAS**, the Parties previously entered into an Agreement dated November 16, 2023, granting the Agency an amount not to exceed \$350,000.00 to assist the Agency's mission to end homelessness, identified by No. 14004 (the "Agreement"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties previously entered into a First Amendment to the Agreement dated August 14, 2024, (the "First Agreement") through which the Agency's Proposed Budget was updated; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agency has requested to amend their Proposed Budget contained in Exhibit 2 of the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desires to amend the Agreement to extend the term of the Agreement to December 31, 2024 and to update the Agency's Proposed Budget and to do as otherwise provided herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the County and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- A. Amendment. Section #2, of the Agreement titled "Term", sub-section A is amended to read as follows:
  - A. This Agreement shall commence on December 1, 2023 (effective date) and continue through December 31, 2024, unless earlier terminated as provided for rein.
- B. <u>Amendment</u>. Exhibit #2, of the Agreement titled "Proposed Budget" is amended and replaced with an updated Proposed Budget as attached to this Amendment.
- C. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Second Amendment shall be effective upon execution by both Parties.
- D. <u>Original Agreement</u>. Unless expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the original Agreement between the Parties, including any prior amendments to the Agreement, shall be and remain in full force and effect. In the event any of the prior amendments to the Agreement conflict with this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
