Description:

Fourth Amendment to Agreement with EOLA Power LLC (11782) for 21-233 Annual Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) Maintenance for Facilities Management. This amendment amends the Government Minimum Wage, the Equipment List and adds a Contract Closeout Checklist.

Recommended Action:

Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Fourth Amendment to Agreement 11782 with EOLA Power LLC, not to exceed \$90,551.30 annually.

Background:

County Manager, Michelle Lieberman, approve the Third Amendment to Agreement 11782 with Eola Power, LLC for 21-233 Annual Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) Maintenance.

The Annual UPS Maintenance is to furnish Preventative Maintenance twice a year for uninterrupted

power supply units and complete battery maintenance including diagnostics, replacement and testing at the County's facilities located in Alachua County, Florida.

BID 21-233 Annual Uninterruptible Power Supply Product and Maintenance was advertised on April 15, 2020 and April 22, 2020. The deadline for receipt BID 21-233 Annual Uninterruptible Power Supply Product and Maintenance was July 8, 2020, nine (9) vendors responded.
