Description:

Second Amendment to the agreement between Alachua County and the University of Florida Board of Trustees for Medical Director and Assistant Medical Director Services to amend the Compensation.

Prior Board Motions:

On September 26, 2023, the Board approved the First Amendment to the Agreement with the University of Florida Board of Trustees (Item #23-00568).

Fiscal Note:

Beginning in FY2023/24, the Medical Director and Assistant Medical Director Services increased from \$103,000.00 to \$150,000.00. The second amendment adds a 3% annual increase beginning FY2024/25. This will increase the annual payment to \$154,500.00 (091.54.5450.526.31.60 Professional Services Medical) for FY2024/25. There is sufficient budget within the Fire Rescue Emergency Medical Services proposed operating budget to cover the increase for FY2024/25.

Background:

Alachua County entered into an agreement with the University of Florida Board of Trustees for Medical Director and Associate Medical Director services on October 1, 2020. The team is responsible for developing medical protocols, educating and training Alachua County Fire Rescue employees as each employee works under the license of the Medical Director, and assists the Department by providing direction and input in pre-hospital medical equipment, methods, and practices.

The Board previously approved a First Amendment on September 26, 2023, increasing the FY2023/24 annual payment to \$150,000.00. The Second Amendment adds a 3% annual increase beginning in FY2024/25. This increases the annual payment to \$154,500.00 for FY2024/25.
