

**#13921 SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR ANNUAL LAWN MAINTENANCE  
NW/SW LANDFILLS AND RCC NO. 13921**

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT (“Amendment”) is made by and between Alachua County, Florida, a political subdivision and charter county of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (the “County”) and Boone Improvements Inc, a Florida for Profit Corporation which is authorized to do business in the State of Florida (“Contractor”), who are collectively referred to as the “Parties”.

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the Parties previously entered into an Agreement dated September 28, 2023 for Annual Lawn Maintenance at NW/SW Landfills and Rural Collection Centers, identified by No. 13921 (the “Agreement”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties previously entered into the First Amendment to the Agreement, dated May 22, 2024, for purposes of amending the Rate Schedule (the “First Amendment); and

**WHEREAS**, the County has elected its option to renew the term of the original Agreement to allow the Contractor to continue to furnish the goods or services to Alachua County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desires to amend the Agreement to extend the term and to do as otherwise provided herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the County and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

A. Amendment. Section # 3 of the Agreement titled “Term” is amended to read:

3. Term. This Agreement is effective on October 1, 2023 (“effective date”) and the term of the Agreement continues until September 30, 2026, unless earlier terminated as provided herein. This Agreement may be amended at the option of the County for one (1) additional two (2) year term at the same terms and conditions outlined herein.

B. Effective Date. This Amendment shall be effective upon execution by both Parties

C. Original Agreement. Unless expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the original Agreement between the Parties, including any prior amendments to the Agreement, shall be and remain in full force and effect. In the event any of the prior amendments to the Agreement conflict with this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.

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
