FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN ALACHUA COUNTY AND CITY OF NEWBERRY FOR FIRE SUPPRESSION & FIRST RESPONSE EMS/RESCUE SERVICES, NO. 11359

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT, by and between Alachua County, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as "County", and the City of Newberry, a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "City", collectively the Count and City are referred to as "Parties".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties hereto previously entered into the Interlocal Agreement for Fire Suppression & First Response EMS/Rescue Services commencing on October 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement to change the Employee Exchange Program And to add Exhibit C ALS Equipment and Supplies List;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- A. <u>Amendment:</u> Section 4, Employee Exchange Program B, is amended to read:
 - B. The County and City will continue the employee exchange under the following terms:
 - The County will provide the City one Firefighter/Paramedic and the City will
 provide the County one Firefighter/EMT on "A" shift until on or before
 September 30, 2024. The respective departments will be responsible for filling
 any vacancies to their own units that occur on this shift.
 - 2. The employee exchange will cease for "B" and "C" shifts on March 13, 2023. The City will staff its engine with a Firefighter/Paramedic and the County will staff its rescue with a Firefighter/EMT. The respective departments will be responsible for filling any vacancies to their own units that occur on these shifts.
 - Medical equipment and supplies will be inventoried and checked for condition and proper functionality prior to March 13, 2023. On March 13, 2023, ownership and responsibility for maintenance and replacement of medical equipment on City units will be transferred to the City.
 - 4. If the City is unable to meet the terms of this proposal by September 30, 2024, ownership will be returned to the County on October 1, 2024.
 - 5. The City and County will share responsibility for Medical Direction, protocols, and Quality Assurance of its employees.
 - The County agrees to continue to allow the City to operate under the County's COPCN and ALS license.

- B. Amendment: Exhibit C, Advanced Lifesaving Equipment and Supply List, as attached to this Amendment is hereto incorporated and made part of the Agreement
- C. This FIRST amendment shall take effect upon the date of execution by the Parties.
- D. Original Agreement. Unless expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the original Agreement between the Parties, including any prior amendments to the Agreement, shall be and remain in full force and effect. In the event any of the prior amendments to the Agreement conflict with this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.

SAVE and EXCEPT as expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the Agreement shall be and remain in full force and effect.
