Background:

In an effort to maximize efficiencies and streamline operations, the County Manager is proposing a re-organization of several departments and offices, effective October 10, 2024. Attached is an organizational chart reflecting the changes graphically, as well as the corresponding Administrative Order.

Per the Alachua County Code - Sec. 21.51. - Establishment, Reorganization and Abolishment. By administrative order, the county manager may establish, reorganize, or abolish departments and 34 offices in the Article III executive branch. The county manager shall provide such administrative order to the board at least 30 calendar days prior to the effective date and in a regularly scheduled business or public hearing meeting to permit the board members to state objections of the manager's order. By a majority vote of the board, the board may overrule an administrative order issued pursuant to this section.
