Sec. 21.51. - Establishment, reorganization and abolishment.

By administrative order, the county manager may establish, reorganize, or abolish departments and offices in the Article III executive branch. The county manager shall provide such administrative order to the board in a regularly scheduled meeting at least 30 calendar days prior to the effective date of the order to permit the board members to state objections of the manager's order. By a majority vote of the board, the board may overrule an administrative order issued pursuant to this section.
