Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, will conduct a public hearing pursuant to Ordinance No. 24-00239 to consider the approval of the imposition and collection of not-d

profit hospital that provides inpatient hospital services and that holds a right of possession and right of use to real property in Alachua County (each, an "Assessed Property"). The list of affected hospitals is included at the conclusion of this notice. The assessments are intended to finance intergovernmental transfers, provided consistent with federal guidelines, that fund the non-federal shape of certain supplemental payment programs. As a result, the assessments directly and specially benefit Assessed Properties and support the provision of health core services to Medicald, indigent, and uninsured members of the County's community.
