**Description:**

This Resolution would allow the County Manager, Director of Public Works/County Engineer, and the Director of Facilities Management to execute governmental applications and permits related to the construction of transportation, structures, and stormwater projects. This amends Resolution No. 2022-62.

**Prior Board Motions:**

June 14, 2022, the Board approved Resolution 2022-62 providing certain authorities related to governmental agency permit applications to the County Manager and the Alachua County Director of the Public Works/County Engineer

**Background:**

To streamline the permitting process for construction projects, the County Manager, the Director of Public Works, the County Engineer, and the Director of Facilities Management are authorized to sign and submit permit applications, compliance documents, and utility agreements for projects related to transportation, structures, and stormwater systems on Alachua County property.

This authority allows these officials to act on behalf of the County when dealing with local, state, and federal agencies, ensuring projects move forward without unnecessary delays. This resolution only applies to permit-related tasks and does not give authority to transfer county-owned property. The Board of County Commissioners can revoke this authority at any time.
