Description:

Agreement 14348 with Tetra Tech Inc. for Monitoring of Disaster Debris and Recovery Activities with not to exceed amount of \$4,000,000 annually.

Recommended Action:

Approve and authorize the Chair to execute Agreement 14348 with Tetra Tech Inc. for Monitoring of Disaster Debris and Recovery Activities, in the amount not to exceed \$4,000,000.00 annually. Also, authorize the County Manager to sign an Agreement for Monitoring of Disaster Debris and Recovery Activities with Goodwyn Mills Cawood FL, LLC, once received signed by such company and approved by the County Attorney's Office as to form.

Prior Board Motions:

08/13/2024, the Board approved the Ranking of Request for Proposal (RFP) 25-74-MM Annual Monitoring of Disaster Debris and Recovery Activities for Solid Waste and Resources Recovery and authorized staff to negotiate agreements with the top 2 ranked firms: (1) Tetra Tech, Inc. and (2) Goodwyn Mills Cawood FL, LLC

With approval of unanticipated revenues for Hurricane Helene which is item #24-933 on the October 8, 2024 agenda, there will be funds available for this contract in the FEMA Disaster Relief Fund in 164.00.0055.525.34.00 with the description of other contractual services.

Background:

In late March 2024, Alachua County received notice that its then current disaster debris, recovery and monitoring vendor would not continue to provide the services to the County. Alachua County released RFP 25-74-MM Annual Monitoring of Disaster Debris and Recovery Activities on April 17, 2024. The deadline for receipt of RFP 25-74-MM Annual Monitoring of Disaster Debris and Recovery Activities was May 22, 2024; seven (7) vendors responded. On August 13, 2024, the Board of County

Commissioners approved the ranking and authorized County staff to negotiate agreements with the top 2 ranked firms: (1) Tetra Tech, Inc. and (2) Goodwyn Mills Cawood FL, LLC The project details can be found here: <https://procurement.opengov.com/portal/alachuacounty/projects/88683>.

The County just recently received the partially signed agreement back from Tetra Tech, Inc. and is awaiting signature of the other agreement with Goodwyn Mills Cowood FL, LLC.
