Proposed amendments to the ULDC landscaping requirements for new developments in Chapter 407, Article IV Landscaping are summarized in list form by code section below. In addition, the Landscaping code has been reorganized overall; section number references are based on the proposed new organization. Landscaping requirements in Article VII Traditional Neighborhood and Transit Oriented Developments and Article IX Stormwater Management that are proposed to be relocated and incorporated into Article IV Landscaping, and related new definitions proposed in Chapter 410, Article III Definitions, are noted where appropriate in this list.
