Youth who attend afterschool programs attend school more often, do better in school, and gain important work and life skills; and nationwide, an estimated 7.7 million children are alone and unsupervised after Whereas, school. The Children's Trust of Alachua County supported 415 local students in afterschool programs in the 2023 school year; and Lights On Afterschool, the national celebration of afterschool programs held on Whereas. October 24, 2024, promotes the importance of quality afterschool programs for our children, families, and communities.
