# **Background:**

For many years the City of Gainesville has provided funding to Alachua County to provide a Victim Advocate Counselor at the Gainesville Police Department. This advocate works with other Victim Services and Rape Crisis Center staff to provide counseling, advocacy, court accompaniment and other services to crime victims. The funds provided fully cover the advocates salary and fringe benefits. The City also provides office space, computer access and a city owned vehicle for official use.
