RE: NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PUBLIC NUISANCE

Ms. Martin and Mr. Martin,

The above-described property remains in violation of the Alachua County Code (Code Case #CEB16-011) and amounts to a public nuisance. The property is creating or containing a threat to life, safety, or welfare. As a result of your failure to address the conditions described in the Notice of Public Nuisance within the 30 calendar days provided, this letter serves as notice to you that the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners will consider at a public hearing whether to authorize the County to abate the nuisance. The date, time and location of the public hearing are as follows:

Time: 11:30 AM, or as soon thereafter can be heard by the Board

If authorization is received, the County will enter the property and remedy the conditions and abate the nuisance, at your expense and cost, including through a non-ad valorem special assessment on the property. Any articles of property removed by the County during the process of nuisance abatement may be destroyed or sold for salvage and the County may retain the salvage value, if any, of such article or articles, to be applied against the cost of removal and destruction thereof.
