

- Tier "C" (BoCC approval required) due to requested duration (14 days)


## Background

- Temporary tents, food trucks, portable restrooms, bleachers
- Shuttle buses for participants














Conceptual Plan of event

## Proposed conditions

- Staff has proposed conditions for the Temporary Use Permit related to:
  - Permit duration
  - Event hours
  - Parking
  - Noise
  - Prohibition on sale of alcohol

# Staff's bases for approval

1. Policy 7.1.17, FLUE (evaluation of land uses through the TUP process)

2. Chapter 402.152, ULDC (general standards of TUP)

#### Staff recommendation

• Staff recommends that the Board adopt Resolution Z-24-6 approving the requested temporary use permit for the 2025 World Masters Championship.

#### Staff's proposed conditions

- 1. The temporary use permit shall be valid from March 23, 2025 through April 2, 2025.
- Event hours shall be from 7 am to 8 pm.
- 3. All event parking shall be accommodated on site and within the area shown on the site plan. There shall be no parking on the right-of way along W. Newberry Road.
- 4. Compliance with the Alachua County Noise Ordinance (Chapter 110) shall be required.
- 5. The sale of alcoholic beverages shall be prohibited.
- 6. Proof of insurance (Certificate of Liability naming Alachua County as an additional insured) shall be provided a minimum of 90 calendar days ahead of the event.
- 7. Non-compliance with any of these conditions shall be considered a violation of this Temporary Use Permit and shall be grounds for revocation of the permit.
