
- Provide an update on Phase I of the Facilities Master Plan adopted in January 2023.

ELEMENTS OF PHASE I

Phase I consisted of the following projects:

- Civil Court Complex
 - CEP
 - Parking Garage
 - Court Services
- New Animal Services Facility
- Armory (Purchase, Renovation & Move: EOC & Fire Rescue HQ)
- Fire Rescue HQ (Renovation & Move: EPD and Growth Management)



CHILLED WATER CENTRAL ENERGY PLANT (CEP)

- CEP skid is completed, Delivery scheduled for December 2024.
- Project consists of CEP building, screen wall, and the utility connections to the Civil/Criminal Courthouse.
- Construction Start: January 2025
- Construction Completion: May 2025 5 Months
- Est. Project Cost: \$6.3 Million*

*All inclusive cost



PARKING GARAGE

- FinFrock is a Design Build firm, and they are handling the A&E & Construction.
- Currently in the final phase of construction plans for the project.
- FinFrock will provide 100% Construction Documents in February 2025.

Construction Start: February 2025 10 Months

Construction Completion: November 2025

• Est. Project Cost: \$12.5 Million

CIVIL COURTHOUSE & COURT SERVICES

- Currently in the A&E phase of the project.
- DLR Group (A&E) will provide 100% Construction Documents in February 2025.
- Ajax (CMAR) will provide a GMP in February 2025.
- A&E Completion: December 2025
- Construction Start: March 2025 20 Months
- Construction Completion: November 2026
- Est. Project Cost: \$70 Million*

ANIMAL RESOURCE FACILITY

- A&E and CMAR awarded. Contract negotiations ongoing.
- Working with the University of Florida on a Term Lease Agreement and VetMed for an MOU.
- A&E Start: October 2024 12 Months
- Construction Start: January 2026 12 Months
- Construction Completion: January 2027
- Estimated Project Cost: \$27.5 Million



NEW FIRE RESCUE HQ / EMERGENCY OPERATIONS

- · Bids received on October 2nd to renovate the building.
- EOC and Fire Rescue HQ will be moving to this building.
- Renovation Start: December 2024 8 Months
- Renovation Completion: July 2025



ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION RELOCATION

- EPD will move to this location once Fire Rescue moves to the Armory.
- Renovation Start: July 2025 4 Months
- Renovation Completion: October 2025
- Relocation Start: October 2025



WAREHOUSE

• Working on a Master space plan that will allocate space for Public Health, Fire Rescue, and Food Programming.

- Square Footage at the site:
 - 61,203 SQFT Warehouse Space
 - 12,680 SQFT Office Space
 - 2,500 SQFT Vehicle Maintenance Building

Phase I Impact:

- Facilities Management will move to this location.
- Growth Management will move to the existing Facilities Office.
- Master Planning: December 2024
- Relocation Start: December 2024





BUDGET INN

• Finished with the A&E and the project is currently being hard bid.



SCOTTISH INN

- Almost finished with A&E, should have construction documents by the end of October 2024.
- Will go out to bid end at the end of November for renovations.
- Construction Start: January 2025 12 Months
- Construction Completion: January 2026
- Construction Budget: \$4 Million



SUNRISE RESIDENCE INN

- Facilities will begin base level repairs when we have closed on the property.
- Base level repairs include items that need immediate attention.
- Repairs Start: October 2024 12 Months
- Repairs Completion: October 2025



LAND CONSERVATION COMPLEX


• Currently in the A&E design phase of the project. Site plan work has been completed.

A&E Completion: June 2025

Construction Start: July 2025 11 Months


Construction Completion: March 2026

Construction Budget: \$7.6 Million



RURAL COLLECTION CENTER

- We are in discussions with the City of Newberry regarding the purchase of 5 acres at their proposed Environmental Park on SR 337.
- Project Start: Property Ownership
- Project Completion: TBD
- Project Budget: \$1.5 Million



HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION FACILITY - ECO LOOP

- UF Consultants estimate a project cost of 4 Million.
- We are applying for the EPA grant due in December, hoping to secure it to cover the budget shortfall.
- After construction, the existing Hazardous Waste building will be renovated to serve as the new Bulk Storage Facility.
- Project Start: Grant Award
- Project Completion: TBD
- Project Budget: \$1.5 Million



PHASE II CONSIDERATIONS

Staff will present considerations in Spring 2025 regarding the next steps (Phase II) of the Facilities Master Space Plan for inclusion in the FY26 CIP Budget. Some preliminary considerations:

- Administration/IT/Tax Collector/Finance & Accounting/Property Appraiser to Existing Civil Courthouse
- What is next for:
 - Wilson Building
 - Administration Building
 - Administration Annex
