Background:

On October 25, 2022 the BoCC approved the Recovery Plan Closing Health Care Disparities with Community Health Care Workers and Improving Health Care Communications. A subrecipient agreement was approved on April 11, 2023, tasking the Department of Health with hiring an Administrator for the CHW Program. This agreement was executed on April 18, 2023 and was effective for 2 years from the date of execution. The Administrator position was filled in October, 2023 and the contract extension will allow for the Administrator position to be funded for two years from the hire date.
