#### **ELEMENTS OF PHASE I**

#### Phase I of the Master Plan

- Civil Court Complex
  - Central Energy Plant (CEP)
  - Parking Garage
  - Civil Courthouse
- Construction of a new Animal Services Facility
- Renovation of the Armory (Move: EOC & Fire Rescue HQ)
- Fire Rescue HQ (Move: EPD and Growth Management)



# CHILLED WATER CENTRAL ENERGY PLANT (CEP)

- CEP Delivered in December 2024.
- Site Plan approved in December 2024.
- Building Permit received in December 2024.

- Est. Construction Start: February 2025
- Est. Construction Completion: June 2025
- Est. Project Cost: \$6.3 Million



#### **PARKING GARAGE**

- FinFrock will provide 100% Construction Documents in February 2025.
- DRB Meeting with City of Gainesville tonight, January 28th.
- All permits should be finalized in February.
- Site work will start in February 2025.
- Precast erection to start in early May 2025.
- Permitting: April 2025
- Est. Construction Start: May 2025
- Est. Construction Completion: December 2025
- Est. Project Cost: \$12.5 Million

#### CIVIL COURTHOUSE & COURT SERVICES

- · Currently in the Construction Document phase of the project.
- DLR Group (A&E) will provide 100% Construction Documents in February 2025.
- Ajax (CMAR) will provide a GMP in February 2025.
- DRB Meeting should be in March/April 2025.
- A&E Completion: February 2025
- Est. Construction Start: August 2025
- Est. Construction Completion: February 2027
- Est. Project Cost: \$70 Million

#### **ANIMAL RESOURCE FACILITY**

- A&E contract to BoCC in February 2025.
- Negotiations for the CMAR contract are currently in progress.
- Discussions are ongoing with UF for a Term Lease Agreement.

• A Memorandum of Understanding is being negotiated with VetMed.

- A&E Start: January 2025 Approx 1 year
- Est. Construction Start: January 2026
- Est. Construction Completion: January 2027
- Estimated Project Cost: \$27.5 Million



#### NEW FIRE RESCUE HQ / EMERGENCY OPERATIONS

- Bids received in October 2024.
- Recommended award to Ulloa Management Group, LLC.
- Contractor approved by Board on January 14, 2025.
- Contract finalization in process.
- Renovation Start: January 2025
- Renovation Completion: July 2025
- Renovation Cost: \$3.7 million
- Relocation Start: July 2025



#### **ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION RELOCATION**

- EPD from the Wilson Building to the existing Fire Rescue Headquarters.
- This will leave the Wilson Building (14 N.E. 1st Street,) vacant.
- Renovations will be needed to transition from Fire Rescue operations to Environmental Protection operations.
- Renovation Start: July 2025
- Renovation Completion: October 2025
- Relocation Start: October 2025



#### WAREHOUSE

- 61,203 SQFT Warehouse Space
- Fire Rescue, Health Department, Supervisor of Elections will utilize the space initially.
- Currently working with A&E on master space plan for all users that will utilize the space.

#### **Phase I Impact:**


- Facilities Management moved in December 2024.
- Growth Management will move to the existing Facilities
   Office near Depot Park.
- Master Planning: Through February 2025
- Relocation Completed



#### **BUDGET INN**

- A&E is complete.
- Bids are due tomorrow, January 29th.
- Project deadline of September 30th.
- Construction Start: February 2025
- Construction Completion: September 2025
- Construction Budget: \$4.2 Million



#### **SCOTTISH INN**


- A&E is complete.
- Bids were due on January 15, 2025.
- Evaluation and contract finalization are in progress.
- Construction Start: February 2025
- Construction Completion: September 2025
- Construction Budget: \$5.5 Million



#### **CONTAINER HOME PROJECT**

- Site plan has been completed.
- Base unit is under construction
- Construction Start: February 2025
- Construction Completion: September 2025
- Construction Budget: \$1.5 Million\*

\*An allocated portion of Scottish Inn funding



#### **SUNRISE RESIDENCE INN**


 Facilities is beginning base level repairs/upgrades (ex: Fire Alarm Panel, Roof, Railing/Stairs, etc.)

- Construction Start: January 2025
- Construction Completion: Ongoing
- Repair/Renovation Budget: \$2.8 Million



# LAND CONSERVATION COMPLEX

- A&E in Schematic Design Phase.
- Land use and rezoning approved in December 2024.
- Submitting for site plan approval in February 2025.
- A&E Completion: June 2025
- Construction Start: September 2025
- Construction Completion: June 2026
- Construction Budget: \$7.6 Million



#### RURAL COLLECTION CENTER

- We are in discussions with the City of Newberry regarding the potential purchase of 5 acres at their proposed Environmental Park on SR 337.
- Aiming to develop a model for an ideal collection center.
- Construction Start: Property Ownership
- Construction Completion: TBD
- Construction Budget: \$1.5 Million




#### **HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION FACILITY - ECO LOOP**

- UF Consultants estimate a project cost of 4 Million.
- Applied for an EPA grant in December, hoping to secure it to cover the budget shortfall.
- After construction, the existing HW building will be renovated to serve as the new bulk storage facility.
- Construction Start: Grant Determination
- Construction Completion: TBD
- Construction Budget: \$1.5 Million



## **TECH CITY FIRE RESCUE STATION**

- Re-use contract with Lunz Group for the A&E services.
- Renewing the Donation Agreement with the property owner.
- A&E Start: March 2025
- Construction Start: October 2025
- Construction Completion: July 2026
- Construction Budget: \$7.2 Million



## **FARMERS MARKET**

- Competing needs Currently sharing space with Fire Station 33, CSW, and the Fire Training Facility.
- **Fire Rescue:** Seeking space onsite to construct Fire Training Tower.
- Farmers Market: Seeking additional space to grow and expand their market.
- Possible Options:
  - Farmers Market relocation
  - Expand the current site
  - Maintain the current configuration



#### **FARMERS MARKET CONTINUED**

#### Farmers Market Relocation

- o Identify a new site that meets operational needs.
- Consider accessibility and community impact

#### Expand the Current Site

- Explore a potential land swap with the City of Gainesville
- Still need to assess feasibility and mutual benefits.

#### Alter the Current Site

- Evaluate adjustments to make both uses coexist as effectively as possible.
- o Identify operational and logistical compromises.
