# Meeting Minutes

#### 1) Call to Order

Action: BJ Bukata was permitted to participate remotely in tonight's meeting as a voting member by a vote of 8-0.

#### a) Approval of Agenda

Motion was made by Bruce Blackwell to approve the agenda. Paul Lyrene second the motion. Action: Agenda for the August 22, 2024 meeting of the LCB approved by a vote of 9-0.

#### 3) Approval of Minutes from June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2024

Motion was made by Tom Mirti to approve the meeting minutes from the June 27, 2024 meeting. Kate Lee seconded the motion. Action: Minutes from the June 27, 2024 meeting of the LCB were approved by a vote of 9-0.

#### 4) **Property Evaluations – Staff Presentations**

Board Members Amy Schwarzer (5:45) and Dewanye Baines (5:47) now in attendance.

 a) Watermelon Pond – Eichhorn – presented by Mike Nelson Nominated by owner as a fee simple acquisition Representative for the property, Realtor Randy Hunziker, attended the meeting virtually and spoke about the legal access to the property provided by the adjacent Johnson property. Said owner is a third-generation owner and is happy to contribute to the conservation land in Alachua County. <u>Motion</u>: Bruce Blackwell moved to place property in the eligibility pool Lee Cook seconded the motion. <u>Action</u>: Watermelon Pond- Eichhorn property was placed I the eligibility pool by a vote of 11-0. <u>Motion</u>: Paul Lyrene moved to place property in the priority pool. Kate Lee seconded the motion. Action: Watermelon Pond- Eichhorn property was placed in the priority pool by a vote

<u>Action</u>: Watermelon Pond- Eichhorn property was placed in the priority pool by a vote of 11-0.

#### b) Watermelon Pond – Hawkins – *presented by Milo Neelands*

Nominated by owner as a fee simple acquisition.

<u>Motion</u>: Tom Mirti moved to place property in the eligibility pool. Amy Schwarzer seconded the motion.

<u>Action</u>: Watermelon Pond- Hawkins property was placed in the eligibility pool by a vote of 11-0.

<u>Motion</u>: Amy Schwarzer moved to place property in the priority pool. Tom Mirti seconded the motion.

<u>Action</u>: Watermelon Pond- Hawkins property was placed in the priority pool by a vote of 11-0

<u>Public comment</u>: Member of the public, Jason Teisinger, asked a clarifying question about the meaning of strategic ecosystem in the evaluation of properties. He expressed support for the Rayonier properties later in the agenda (4d) and shared about the current development of Rayonier properties elsewhere in the state.

# c) Lochloosa Creek Flatwoods – Little Orange Development LLC – *presented by Cory Gillis*

Nominated by Putnam Land Conservancy (PLC) Two members of the PLC were present at the meeting. They showed a map of the Ocalato-Osceola (O2O) Wildlife Corridor and the potential connection of this property to the O2O. The PLC submitted this project along with others as a proposed Florida Forever project area.

<u>Motion</u>: Dwayne Baines moved to place property in the eligibility pool. Kristen Young seconded the motion.

<u>Action</u>: Lochloosa Creek Flatwoods – Little Orange Lake Investors, LLC property was placed in the eligibility pool by a vote of 10-1, with Tom Mirti in dissent.

<u>Motion</u>: Dwayne Baines moved to place the property in the priority pool. Motion failed for lack of a second.

LCB members requested that staff bring the property back to the LCB when either the Lakes Hawthorne LLC property is nominated for ACF acquisition, or the Florida Forever application is approved. Putnam Land Conservancy will update staff on the Florida Forever application.

#### d) Alachua County – Rayonier – presented by Andi Christman

North Florida Land Trust nominated properties as fee simple acquisitions or conservation easements.

<u>Motion</u> was made by Kristen Young to place the (1.) NE Flatwoods/Buck Bay Flatwoods – Rayonier: Connector, (2.) Lake Santa Fe Rayonier: Saluda Swamp, (3.) Northeast Flatwoods/Santa Fe River Rayonier – CR225/River, and (4.) Austin Cary Flatwoods – Rayonier: Little Hatchet Creek properties in the eligibility pool. Lee Cook second the motion.
