Background:

The Land Conservation Board (LCB) was created by the Board of County Commissioners in 2000. The eleven citizen (plus one alternate) Land Conservation Board recommends environmentally significant properties to the Board of County Commissioners for inclusion on the Alachua County Forever Acquisition List and makes recommendations on stewardship issues. The 11 member board consists of 6 voting members with natural resource education and experience and 5 citizen-at-large voting members, plus 1 alternate citizen-at-large member. This agenda item seeks to fill 2 citizen-at-large voting members and 1 alternate citizen-at-large member positions.
