THIRD AMENDMENT PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN ALACHUA COUNTY AND REBUILDING TOGETHER NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA NO. 13489

THIS Third AMENDMENT ("Amendment") is made by and between Alachua County, Florida, a political subdivision and charter county of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (the "County") and REBUILDING TOGETHER NCF INC, a Not for Profit Corporation which is authorized to do business in the State of Florida ("Contractor"), who are collectively referred to as the "Parties".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into an Agreement, dated December 20, 2022, for a Pilot for Energy Efficiency and Weatherization of Affordable Housing Grant Management Services (the "Project"), identified by No. 13489, with the option to increase to a full program at the discretion of the County (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS the Parties previously entered into the First Amendment to the Agreement, dated June 29, 2023, through which the Scope of Services of the Agreement was modified (the "First Amendment"); and

WHEREAS the Parties previously entered into the Second Amendment to the Agreement, dated January 11, 2024, through which the County added funds to expand the scale and continue the Pilot Project (the "First Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, on November 12, the County Board of County Commissioners approved moving from the Pilot to the Full Project with a total potential cost of \$3,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement to initiate the Full Program and to do as otherwise provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- A. <u>Amendment.</u> Paragraph 5 of the Agreement titled "Payment" is amended to read as follows:
 - 5. Payment.
 - A. The County will pay, and Contractor will accept, for the timely and complete performance of the Services described in this Agreement, payment based on the rates or pricing contained in the Updated Project Budget attached hereto as Exhibit "3" and incorporated herein by this reference, as attached to this Third Amendment. The Parties agree that the amount to be paid to the Contractor for the Services required for the Project will not exceed the sum of \$2,953,670.46 This sum includes previously allocated \$524,785.77 for the original Pilot Phases under the Agreement an additional \$1,075,878.91 for the first year of the Full Project and \$1,353,005.78 for the second year of the Full Project, that the County is now allocating for the Project.

As a condition precedent for any payment, Contractor must submit monthly В. invoices to the County requesting payment for Services properly rendered and expenses due, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the County. Contractor's invoice must describe the Services rendered, the date performed, and hours expended and the person(s) rendering such Services. Contractor's invoice shall be accompanied by documentation or data in support of expenses, as the County may require. The invoice shall reflect the allocations as provided and shall state the percentage of completion as to each such allocation. Each invoice shall constitute the Contractor's representation to the County that the Services listed have reached the level stated, have served a public purpose, have been properly and timely performed, that the expenses included in the invoice have been reasonably incurred in accordance with this Agreement, that all obligations of Contractor covered by prior invoices have been paid in full, and that the amount requested is currently due and owing. Submission of the Contractor's invoice for final payment shall further constitute the Contractor's representation to the County that, upon receipt by the Contractor of the amount invoiced, all obligations of the Contractor to others, including its consultants and subcontractors, will be paid in full. Contractor shall submit invoices to the County at the following address, unless otherwise directed by the County:

- D. The County will make payment to Contractor for amounts properly invoiced, as set out below, and in accordance with the provisions of the Florida Prompt Payment Act, Chapter 218, Part VII, Florida Statutes.
- E. If the County has reasonable cause to suspect that any representations of Contractor relating to payment are inaccurate, the County may withhold payment of sums then or in the future otherwise due to Contractor until the inaccuracy, and the cause thereof, is corrected to the County Manager's or his/her designee's reasonable satisfaction.
- F. The County's performance and obligation to pay under this Agreement is contingent upon a specific annual appropriation by the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners ("Board"). The Parties hereto understand that this Agreement is not a commitment of future appropriations. Continuation of this Agreement beyond the term or the end of any County fiscal year shall be subject to both the appropriation and the availability of funds in accordance with Chapter 129, Florida Statutes; and that the failure of the Board to do so shall not constitute a breach or default of this Agreement.
- G. In the event any part of this Agreement or the Services, is to be funded by Federal, State, or other local agency monies, Contractor agrees to cooperate with County in

order to assure compliance with all requirements of the funding entity applicable to the use of the monies, including providing access to and the right to examine relevant

documents related to the Services and as specifically required by the granting agency, and receiving no payment until all required forms are completed and submitted.

- C. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Amendment shall be effective upon execution by both Parties
- D. <u>Original Agreement</u>. Unless expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the original Agreement between the Parties, including any prior amendments to the Agreement, shall be and remain in full force and effect. In the event any of the prior amendments to the Agreement conflict with this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
