

RESOLUTION 25-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF SURPLUS SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS EQUIPMENT TO LOFTEN HIGH SCHOOL, THE CITY OF HIGH SPRINGS, AND THE CITY OF NEWBERRY, FOR USE IN PROVIDING PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 125.38, Florida Statutes, any department or agency of the United States or other organization not for profit, organized for the purpose of promoting community interest and welfare, that desires to obtain County personal property may apply to the Board of County Commissioners for conveyance of such property; and,

WHEREAS, the Alachua County Fire Rescue Department has replaced the self-contained breathing apparatus system with a newer system that has significant safety and communication upgrades; and,

WHEREAS, the Loften High School, City of High Springs, and City of Newberry have requested property which will serve public or community interest and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, the County's Fire Rescue Department has determined that the property is not needed for County purposes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. The Board finds, determines and declares that the recitals in the preamble are true and correct, and hereby incorporates them by reference.

2. The Board hereby authorizes the transfer of the following equipment: seventeen (17) air packs and seventeen (17) bottles to Lofton High School, twenty (20) voice amplifiers to the City of High Springs, and eight (8) air packs and twelve (12) bottles to the City of Newberry.

3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
