Background:

The City of Gainesville, as Gainesville Regional Utilities, owns the property between Veteran's Memorial Park and the Lake Kanapaha conservation area. On November 19, 2013, the City granted the County an Easement for Ingress/Egress across its property, connecting to SW 41st Place. The County intends to use the easement for a portion of the Archer Braid Trail.

In 2024, the City requested that the County release the easement to allow for the expansion of GRU's water reclamation facility on the property. County staff requested, and the City agreed to provide, a replacement Easement for Public Access Ingress/ Egress along the south edge of the City's property. Alachua County Public Works has reviewed the proposed replacement easement corridor and
