My Teaching Philosophy:

As a Social Studies teacher, I have found that the most important thing we do as educators is to prepare our students for the real world. That is why I believe in instruction that is unbiased, strengthens character, and is accessible to all.

To begin with, my learning community encourages freedom of thought among students while at the same time respecting the differences that make each of them so unique. For example, when teaching historical events, I present multiple perspectives to ensure students understand that history is complex and often viewed differently depending on one's background and experiences. This approach helps students develop critical thinking skills and form their own informed opinions.

Second, the characteristics of leadership, perseverance, and discipline are promoted daily in my classroom through the use of historical examples and influential figures who demonstrate these traits. For instance, I highlight figures such as Frederick Douglass, Eleanor Roosevelt, and Cesar Chavez to showcase how these qualities have driven impactful change. By connecting these traits to real-world success, students gain a deeper understanding of how these values can shape their own futures.

Finally, when creating lesson plans, I strive to teach the content in ways that make it accessible to all my students. I incorporate differentiated instruction strategies such as station rotations, hands-on activities, and technology integration to ensure every learner can engage meaningfully with the material. By connecting historical concepts to students' lives, I make the content relatable rather than just a series of random facts they forget once class is over.

I believe that if all of this is done on a daily basis, then we as educators are setting up the next generation for success in the challenges they will face moving into the 21st century. Through the delivery of unbiased instruction, encouraging character growth, and promoting differentiation, I believe that we can help all students reach their full potential.
