




Figure 4: Reported Level of Walking Comfort by Facility Type

What Bicycle Facility Do You Feel Comfortable **Biking** On? (Mark All That Apply)










Bike Level of Traffic Stress (LTS)



- **CONNECTED NETWORK:** Filling gaps, connecting people to places, and informing decision regarding tradeoffs in street projects.
- **EQUITY:** Being inclusive of diverse populations, addressing historic inequities, and supporting people who depend upon active transportation projects the most.
- Increased Multimodal Trips: Encouraging and supporting more people to walk, bike, and roll.
- IMPLEMENTATION: Helping projects get built by ensuring access through policy, design, construction, operations, maintenance and funding of projects.




