- 1. County Manager Michele Lieberman is a member of the International City/County Management Association (ICMA) Global Engagement Committee.
- 2. The 2025 Global Exchange is ICMA's Annual International Regional Meeting and will take place in Eswatini and South Africa from September 2 through September 12, 2025.
- 3. The County's travel policy states, "Any international travel will require prior approval from the Administrating Official and will be submitted as an agenda item for approval by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners at a Regular meeting."
- 4. Attendees of the Exchange will meet with ICMA strategic alliance organizations, participate in joint local conferences and learn more about local government practices in each country.

- 5. Participants will also have opportunities to participate in speaking engagements and strategic planning exercise focused on the professionalization of local governments.
- 6. The Exchange promotes two-way knowledge sharing to strengthen global local governance. Attendees will be encouraged to share the knowledge and insights gained with their home communities.
