On May 21, 2025, in probate case #2025-CP-0441, Alachua County e-filed a Statement of Claim in the amount of \$2,401.81 for ambulance services provided to the deceased, Robert Reid Morrison. On May 27, 2025, Alachua County received an Objection to Claim from John A. Williams, the Personal Representative of the Estate. Pursuant to Florida Probate Rule 5.496 and Florida Statutes, Section 733.705, Alachua County is limited to a period of 30 days from the date of service of the objection within which to bring an action on its claim.
