Alachua County entered the AARP Network of Age-Friendly States and Communities in October 2019. As a requirement to join the Age-Friendly Community Network, Alachua County had to first apply with the support of Alachua County Commissioners, commit to assess the needs of their older residents, and to create a 3-5-year action plan to address those needs. The 2019 Age-Friendly Alachua Action Plan was developed in alignment with the Alachua County Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP).
