Whereas,	firearms are the leading cause of death for children and teens in the United States; and
Whereas,	Alachua County is committed to fostering a safe and supportive environment that promotes the well-being of all children; and
Whereas,	almost every day in the United States, a child gains access to a firearm and unintentionally injures or kills themselves or someone else; and
Whereas,	research shows that the most effective way to prevent children from accessing firearms is by making sure all guns are stored unloaded, locked, and separate from ammunition; and
Whereas,	both gun owners and non-gun owners have a role to play in promoting secure firearm storage and preventing unauthorized access by children and teens; and
Whereas,	more than half of gun owners do not lock all their firearms securely, and approximately 4.6 million children in the United States live in homes with at least one unlocked and loaded firearm; and
Whereas,	schools, hospitals, state agencies, and community organizations are committed to their crucial role in reducing injuries and deaths by promoting secure gun storage and safety; and
Whereas,	Be SMART Week raises awareness and promotes public education about responsible gun ownership and the importance of storing firearms securely; and
Whereas,	 S – Secure all guns, M – Model responsible behavior around guns, A – Ask about unsecured guns in other homes, R – Recognize the role of guns in suicide, T – Tell your peers to be SMART!
