

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT TO CREATE JOINT CLIMATE AND
WATER POLICY BOARD**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT ("First Amendment") is made by and between **Alachua County**, a charter county and political subdivision of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (the "County") and **City of Gainesville**, a Florida municipal corporation, by and through its City Commission (the "City"). The City and County are collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually referred to as each "Party."

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into an Interlocal Agreement Creating the Joint Water and Climate Policy Board with an Effective Date of December 3, 2020 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

A. Section 1 of the Agreement is amended as follows:


1. **Term of Agreement; Recording.** This Agreement shall become effective on December 3, 2020 (the "Effective Date"), for a term ending on December 31, 2030, for a term of five years, ending on December 31, 2025, unless earlier terminated or extended as provided herein. Pursuant to Section 163.01(11), Florida Statutes, the County shall record a fully executed copy of this Agreement, and any amendments thereto, in the Official Records of Alachua County, Florida.

B. Except as expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the Agreement between the Parties, including any prior amendments to the Agreement, remain in full force and effect. In the event of any conflict, the provisions of this First Amendment will prevail over the provisions of the Agreement and any prior amendments to the Agreement.
