**Background:**

Pursuant to Florida Statute 121.055 the BoCC must ask the state for a new position to be designated as part of the Senior Management Service Class. "...positions to be included in the class are designated by the local agency employer. Notice of intent to designate positions for inclusion in the class must be published for at least 2 consecutive weeks if published on a publicly accessible website as provided in s. 50.0311 or, if published in print, once a week for 2 consecutive weeks in a newspaper qualified under chapter 50 that is published in the county or counties affected." To be eligible for Senior Management Service Class pursuant to Florida Statute 121.055, the classification, must be a managerial or policymaking position and the employee must be an at-will employee and either: (1) heads an organization unit; or (2) has responsibility to effect or recommend personnel, budget, expenditure, or policy decisions in their area of responsibility. County staff finds the Director of Tourism and Economic Development meets those criteria for eligibility.
