A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO RECOGNIZE AND RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE FROM THE LYDIA B. STOKES FOUNDATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to receive unanticipated revenue in the Solar Community Investment Fund 124 as outlined in Agreement No. 14802 from the Lydia B. Stokes Foundation;

WHEREAS, the Solar Community Investment Fund 124, is necessary to account for and administer revenues received from a grant award issued from the Lydia B. Stokes Foundation for the initiation and maintenance of a Community Investment Fund through municipal savings achieved via solar array;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. That the creation of the Solar Community Investment fund 124 funded through Agreement 14802 with the Lydia B. Stokes Foundation and the same is hereby, approved.
2. That the fiscal year 2025-26 budget for the Environmental Protection Department – ~~Sustainability~~ Resiliency Division is increased as reflected in the budget amendment attached hereto.
3. By adoption of this resolution, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, fulfills the obligation of Chapter 129.06(2)(d),

F.S., regarding budget amendments, appropriates, and expenditures.

4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
