Background:

The Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) established the Environmental Protection Advisory Committee (EPAC) in 1984 to advise and assist the Board on environmental issues. EPAC is comprised of 11 Board-appointed citizens, plus one alternate, interested in developing effective environmental programs and policies and in promoting greater community involvement in local environmental issues and local governmental programs dealing with these issues. EPAC gathers information, makes recommendations to the Board, and endorses selected environmental policy initiatives.

There are five open positions to the Environmental Protection Advisory Committee. Three of the open positions are full term Citizen at Large positions with terms ending on 09/30/2028, one is a full term Citizen at Large position with a term ending on 09/30/2027, and one is an alternate member position with a term ending 09/30/2026.

The applications for George DeLoach, Jan Frentzen, Timothy Renfroe, John Rosenbeck, and Ian

Kress have been reviewed, and they are all qualified to serve.
