Alachua County has received a Notice of Grant Award from the Corporation of National Community Service, a federally funded agency, in the amount of \$431,672.00 to continue the Foster Grandparent Program (FGP). The Performance Period is for three years from 09/05/2025 to 06/30/2028. This is the third year, and the budget period of the grant is 07/01/2025-06/30/2026. This will be a 12 month budget cycle following the State Fiscal Year
