

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO CONTRACTUAL SERVICES WITH STRYKER LLC  
NO. 13974**

THIS Second AMENDMENT (“Second Amendment”) is made by and between Alachua County, Florida, a political subdivision and charter county of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (the “County”) and STRYKERS SALES CORPORATION, a which is authorized to do business in the State of Florida (“Contractor”), who are collectively referred to as the “Parties”.

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the Parties previously entered into an Agreement dated December 15, 2023, for medical equipment service and maintenance, identified by No. 13974 (the “Agreement”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties previously entered into the First Amendment to the Agreement dated December 12, 2024 (the “First Amendment”); and

**WHEREAS**, the County has elected its option to renew the term of the Agreement to allow the Contractor to furnish the goods or service to Alachua County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement to incorporate the statutory language and affidavit required by Section 787.06(13), Florida Statutes, No Coercion for Labor or Services, to the original Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement to incorporate the statutory language and affidavit required by Section 287.138, Florida Statutes, Contracting with Entities of Foreign Countries of Concern Prohibited, to the original Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desires to amend the Agreement to extend the term and to do as otherwise provided herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the County and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- A. Amendment. In accordance with the updated Stryker quote attached to the Amendment as **Exhibit A** to term of the Agreement is extended through September 30, 2026.
- B. In accordance with the updated Stryker quote attached to the annual cost of the Agreement as **Exhibit A** for the period of October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026 is \$84,045.60
- C. Amendment. The Agreement is amended to add new Section 30, titled “Affidavit of No Coercion Pursuant to §787.06, Florida Statutes” to read as follows:

30. Affidavit of No Coercion

Pursuant to §787.06, Florida Statutes Section 787.06(13), Florida Statutes, requires any governmental entity, when executing, renewing, or extending a contract, must obtain an affidavit from the non-governmental entity attesting that it does not use coercion for labor or services. The terms "coercion" and "labor" are defined respectively in sections 787.06(2)(a) and 787.06(2)(e), Florida Statutes.

The Contractor will certify its compliance with this statutory requirement by completing and executing Affidavit of No Coercion for Pursuant to §787.06, Florida Statutes, a copy of which is attached to this First Amendment as **Exhibit B**.

D. Amendment. The Agreement is amended to add new Section 31, titled “Contracting with Entities of Foreign Countries of Concern Prohibited” to read as follows:

31. Contracting with Entities of Foreign Countries of Concern Prohibited

Section 287.138, Florida Statutes, prohibits any governmental entity from contracting with entities if the contract provides the entity with access to an individual's personal identifying information and:

The entity is owned by the government of a foreign country of concern;

The government of a foreign country of concern has a controlling interest in the entity; or

The entity is organized under the laws of or has its principal place of business in a foreign country of concern.

The statute identifies foreign countries of concern as: The People's Republic of China, the Russian Federation, the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the Republic of Cuba, the Venezuelan regime of Nicolas Maduro, or the Syrian Arab Republic, including any agency of or any other entity of significant control of such foreign country of concern.

The Contractor will certify its compliance with this statutory requirements by completing and executing the Affidavit Regarding Foreign Countries of Concern, a copy of which is attached to this First Agreement as **Exhibit C**.

E. Effective Date. This First Amendment shall become effective upon execution by both Parties.

F. Original Agreement. Unless expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the Agreement shall be and remain in full force and effect. In the event any of the prior amendments to the Agreement conflict with this First Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.

G. Signature Authority. Contractor represents and warrants to the County that the undersigned is authorized to execute this Second Amendment on behalf of the Contractor.
