

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN ALACHUA COUNTY AND
PRITCHETT TRUCKING, NO. 13920**

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT (“Second Amendment”) is made by and between Alachua County, Florida, a political subdivision and charter county of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (the “County”) and PRITCHETT TRUCKING, INC., a Florida for Profit Corporation which is authorized to do business in the State of Florida (“Contractor”), who are collectively referred to as the “Parties”.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into the Agreement for Annual Back-Up and Emergency Hauling , identified by No. 13920 (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into the First Amendment to the Agreement, dated May 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the County has elected its option to renew the term of the Agreement to allow the Contractor to continue furnish the goods or service to Alachua County; and

WHEREAS, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement to incorporate the statutory language and affidavit required by Section 787.06(13), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement to incorporate the statutory language and affidavit required by Section 287.138, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desires to amend the Agreement to extend the term and to do as otherwise provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

A. Amendment. Section 3 of the Agreement titled “Term” is amended to read as follows:

Term. This Agreement is effective upon execution by the Parties and continues through September 30, 2027, unless earlier terminated as provided herein. This Agreement may be amended at the option of the County for one additional two-year term(s) at the same terms and conditions outlined herein. The Contractor may choose not to renew this Agreement with the County, provided the County has received written notice from the Contractor ninety (90) days prior October 1st for each term renewal.

B. Amendment. Exhibit 2 of the Agreement titled “**Rate Schedule**” is deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Exhibit #2 attached to this Second Amendment.

C. Amendment. The Agreement is amended to add new sub-section 15.T titled “Affidavit of No Coercion Pursuant to §787.06, Florida Statutes to read as follows:

T. **Affidavit of No Coercion Pursuant to §787.06, Florida Statutes**

1. Section 787.06(13), Florida Statutes, requires any governmental entity when executing, renewing, or extending a contract, must obtain an affidavit from the non-governmental entity attesting that it does not use coercion for labor or services. The terms "coercion" and "labor" are defined respectively in sections 787.06(2)(a) and 787.06(2)(e), Florida Statutes.

2. The Contractor will certify its compliance with this statutory requirement by completing and executing the Affidavit of No Coercion Pursuant to §787.06, Florida Statutes, a copy of which is attached to the Second Amendment as **Exhibit 5**.

C. Amendment. The Agreement is amended to add new sub-section 15.U titled “Contracting with Entities of Foreign Countries of Concern Prohibited” to read as follows:

U. **Contracting with Entities of Foreign Countries of Concern Prohibited**

1. Section 287.138, Florida Statutes, prohibits any governmental entity from contracting with entities if the contract provides the entity with access to an individual's personal identifying information and:

a. The entity is owned by the government of a foreign country of concern;

b. The government of a foreign country of concern has a controlling interest in the entity; or

c. The entity is organized under the laws of or has its principal place of business in a foreign country of concern.

2. The statute identifies foreign countries of concern as: The People's Republic of China, the Russian Federation, the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the Republic of Cuba, the Venezuelan regime of Nicolas Maduro, or the Syrian Arab Republic, including any agency of or any other entity of significant control of such foreign country of concern.

3. The Contractor will certify its compliance with this statutory requirement by completing and executing the Affidavit Regarding Foreign Countries of Concern, a copy of which is attached to the Second Amendment as **Exhibit 6**.

D. Effective Date. This Second Amendment shall be effective upon execution by both Parties.

E. Original Agreement. Unless expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the Agreement, including any prior amendments to the Agreement, shall be and remain in full

force and effect. In the event any of the prior amendments to the Agreement conflict with this Second Amendment, the provisions of this Second Amendment shall prevail.


