Description:

Second Amendment to Addendum Agreement with Zoll Medical Corporation (14405), for Zoll Medical X Series Monitors/Defibrillators, Extended Warranty and Preventative Maintenance Program, in the amount not to exceed (NTE) \$62,127.50, for Fire Rescue. This amendment extends the term through September 30, 2026, replaces Exhibit 1 and increases the amount of the agreement from \$53,770.00 to \$62,127.50.

Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Second Amendment to Addendum Agreement 14405 with Zoll Medical Corporation in the amount NTE \$62,127.50

Prior Board Motions:

June 10, 2025, the Board approved the First Amendment to Addendum Agreement with Zoll Medical Corporation (14405) for the Extended Warranty and Preventative Maintenance Program for Defibrillators and Monitors, in the amount NTE \$53,770.00, for Fire Rescue. Item 25-00402

Background:

The X Series is a full-featured monitor/defibrillator designed to be used with patients of all ages, its advanced monitoring and defibrillation capabilities extend to children and neonates. CPR Dashboard, SA02 functions and wireless data transfer to hospitals. Preventative maintenance on our current equipment provides enhanced safety for citizens along with cost savings by reducing downtime and increasing the medical unit's lifespan.

Zoll Medical is the sole manufacturer and source of X Series and X Series Advanced Defibrillators for the EMS Market. Zoll service, repairs and upgrades for the X-Series model defibrillators are only available through Zoll Medical.

This purchase is exempt from the County's competitive bidding requirements pursuant to Section 22.3-302 (28) of the Alachua County Procurement Code, Sole Source procurements in accordance with the Procurement Procedures Manual; however, since the dollar amount of the purchase exceeds the purchasing authority of the Procurement Manager, this is being submitted for Board consideration and approval
