Interlocal Agreement for the Enforcement of School Zone Speed Limits

Description:

Interlocal agreement, No. 14669, between Alachua County and Alachua County Sheriff's Office for the implementation of the School Zone Speed Enforcement Program.

Recommended Action:

Approve the interlocal agreement, No. 14669 for the Alachua County School Zone Speed Enforcement and authorize the Chair's signature.

Prior Board Motions:

On May 28, 2024, the Board directed Staff to advertise an ordinance to enact the use of Speed Detection Systems in Alachua County School Zones.

On November 12, 2024 the Board approved the Ordinance 24-17 amending Alachua County Code Chapter 113. to permit camera enforcement of speed limits in school zones as provided for by Chapter 2023-174, Laws of Florida.

Fiscal Note:

State Statute s. 318.18(3)(d) includes the penalties to be assessed and collected by the county and distributed to the various entities. Projected impacts and costs related to program implementation will be evaluated by the BoCC and Alachua County Sheriff's Office Staff after six months.

Background:
