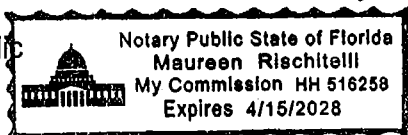

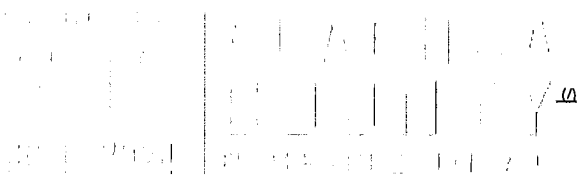

An ordinance establishing Alachua County Commissioner districts in accordance with the the Alachua County Charter and in compliance with the Florida Constitution and Florida Statutes. The establishment of County Commissioner districts serves the public purpose of allowing for representation of Alachua County citizens by dividing the County into five commissioner districts of contiguous territory as nearly equal in population as practicable.
