Background:

The Arts Council discussed promoting the work of Alachua County artists and craftspeople by displaying their work in a lighted, locking cabinet on the first floor of the County Administration Building. Our current art loan program is exclusively for the Jack Durrance Commission Auditorium. The Art Council recommends expanding amending the program, as attached, to allow art to be displayed in other locations within the County Administration Building. They have recommended a lighted, locking display on the first floor. A rotating series of themed exhibitions would be advertised via a Call to Artists, with each exhibition lasting three months.

Themed exhibitions could include:

- * Textiles
- * Ceramics
- * Poetry (printed and framed)

- * Painting & Drawing
- * Photography
- * Small Sculpture
- * Design & Architecture .
