Description:

Agreements with Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. (14801) and Crowder-Gulf Joint Venture, Inc. (14833) for RFP 26-75-MM Annual Disaster Debris Removal, Reduction and Disposal Services, in the amount not to exceed (NTE) \$25,000,000.00, for Solid Waste and Resource Recovery.

Recommended Action:

Approve the award and authorize the Chair to execute Agreements, substantially in the form attached to this agenda item, 14801 with Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. (Primary) and 14833 Crowder-Gulf Joint Venture, Inc. (Secondary) for RFP 26-75-MM Annual Disaster Debris Removal, Reduction and Disposal Services, NTE \$25,000,000.00 annually, with each award to be contingent on the respective contractor executing an annual disaster debris services agreement to be provided to them by the County Manager.

Background:

Alachua County solicited vendors to provide assistance with cleanup and FEMA public assistance after a declared disaster. The vendor must provide disaster debris removal, reduction and disposal services for all eligible materials within the municipalities and the unincorporated areas of Alachua County.

RFP 26-75-MM Annual Disaster Debris Removal, Reduction and Disposal Services was released

June 18, 2025. The deadline for receipt of RFP 26-75-MM Annual Disaster Debris Removal, Reduction and Disposal Services was August 6, 2025; eleven (11) vendors responded.
