A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO RECOGNIZE AND RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE FROM THE ST. JOHNS RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT; TO ADMINISTER REVENUES RECEIVED AND AUTHORIZE EXPENDITURES FROM SAID FUNDS, AND PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Alachua County strives to lead by example by reducing water use at Alachua County facilities;

WHEREAS, Alachua County is receiving funding to assist with upgrades to the irrigation system at Rotary Park at Jonesville to reduce water waste;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to recognize and receive unanticipated revenue in fund 260, the Water Conservation Grant Fund, for the Water Resources Program from the St. Johns River Water Management District;

WHEREAS, it is necessary for this increase to account for and administer revenues received from the St. Johns River Water Management District in order to implement and account for expenses related to this water conservation cost share program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. That the fiscal year 2025-2026 budget for fund 260, Water Conservation Grant Fund, be increased as reflected in the budget amendment attached hereto.
2. By adoption of this resolution, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, fulfills the obligation of Chapter

129.06(2)(d), F.S., regarding budget amendments, appropriations, and expenditures.

3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
