

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP)
OWNER OCCUPIED REHABILITATION PROGRAM PROVIDER AGREEMENT
BETWEEN ALACHUA COUNTY AND ALACHUA HABITAT FOR HUMANITY INC.,
NO 14498**

THIS First AMENDMENT (“First Amendment”) is made by and between Alachua County, Florida, a political subdivision and charter county of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (the “County”) and Habitat for Humanity, a Florida not for Profit Corporation which is authorized to do business in the State of Florida whose principal address is 2610 NW 43rd Street Suite 2B Gainesville, FL 32606 hereinafter referred to as “Provider”. Collectively hereinafter, the County and the Provider are referred to as the “Parties”.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into an Agreement dated December 12, 2024, for the administration and implementation of a Home Repair Program under the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP), identified by No. 14498 (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the County desires to amend the Agreement to extend the term of the Agreement to allow the Contractor to furnish the goods or service to Alachua County; and

WHEREAS, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement to incorporate the statutory language and affidavit required by Section 787.06(13), Florida Statutes, No Coercion for Labor or Services, to the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement to incorporate the statutory language and affidavit required by Section 287.138, Florida Statutes, Contracting with Entities of Foreign Countries of Concern Prohibited, to the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement to extend the term and to do as otherwise provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- A. Amendment. Section #1, of the Agreement titled “Term” is amended to read as follows:

This Agreement shall commence on the date signed by the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners through May 31, 2026, unless earlier terminated, as provided herein. The Parties may mutually agree to extend the term of this Agreement through mutually agreed upon amendments.

- B. Amendment. The Agreement is amended to add new Section 28, titled “Affidavit of No Coercion Pursuant to §787.06, Florida Statutes” to read as follows:

SECTION 28 Affidavit of No Coercion Pursuant to §787.06, Florida Statutes

28.1 Pursuant to §787.06, Florida Statutes Section 787.06(13), Florida Statutes, requires any governmental entity, when executing, renewing, or extending a contract, must obtain an affidavit from the non-governmental entity attesting that it does not use coercion for labor or services. The terms

"coercion" and "labor" are defined respectively in sections 787.06(2)(a) and 787.06(2)(e), Florida Statutes.

28.2 The Provider will certify its compliance with this statutory requirement by completing and executing Affidavit of No Coercion for Pursuant to §787.06, Florida Statutes, a copy of which is attached to this First Amendment as **Attachment 9**.

C. Amendment. The Agreement is amended to add new Section 29, titled "Contracting with Entities of Foreign Countries of Concern Prohibited" to read as follows:

SECTION 29. Contracting with Entities of Foreign Countries of Concern Prohibited

29.1 Section 287.138, Florida Statutes, prohibits any governmental entity from contracting with entities if the contract provides the entity with access to an individual's personal identifying information and:

29.1.1 The entity is owned by the government of a foreign country of concern;

29.1.2 The government of a foreign country of concern has a controlling interest in the entity; or

29.1.3 The entity is organized under the laws of or has its principal place of business in a foreign country of concern.

29.2 The statute identifies foreign countries of concern as: The People's Republic of China, the Russian Federation, the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the Republic of Cuba, the Venezuelan regime of Nicolas Maduro, or the Syrian Arab Republic, including any agency of or any other entity of significant control of such foreign country of concern.

29.3 The Provider will certify its compliance with this statutory requirements by completing and executing the Affidavit Regarding Foreign Countries of Concern, a copy of which is attached to this First Agreement as **Attachment 10**.

D. Effective Date. This First Amendment shall become effective upon execution by both Parties.

E. Original Agreement. Unless expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the Agreement shall be and remain in full force and effect. In the event any of the prior amendments to the Agreement conflict with this First Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.

F. Signature Authority. Provider represents and warrants to the County that the undersigned is authorized to execute this First Amendment on behalf of the Contractor.



3. I attest and affirm that the following is true and correct:



b. The government of a foreign country of concern does not have a controlling interest in Habitat for Humanity.

c. Habitat for Humanity is not organized under the laws of or has its principal place of business in a foreign country of concern.

4. This affidavit is provided to the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners to comply with section 287.138(4) Florida Statutes.
