

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ALACHUA COUNTY  
AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF ALACHUA COUNTY FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY  
ALACHUA COUNTY FIRE RESCUE, NO. 14774**

THIS First AMENDMENT (“First Amendment”) is made by and between Alachua County, Florida, a political subdivision and charter county of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (the “County”) and School Board of Alachua County (“SBAC”), who are collectively referred to as the “Parties”.

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the County and Contractor previously entered into An Interlocal Agreement dated July 3, 2025, to provide fire inspections to SBAC (the “Services”), identified by No. 14774 (the “Agreement”); and

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to extend the term of the Agreement for six months to continue providing the needed Services and to increase the not to exceed amount of the Agreement for the extension of the Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desires to amend the Agreement to extend the term and to do as otherwise provided herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the County and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

A. Amendment. Section #1, of the Agreement titled “Term” is amended to read as follows:

Term: After execution by the Parties, this Amendment shall commence and become effective upon filing as provided in Section 16, below, and continue until terminated as contained herein or superseded by another Interlocal Agreement through July 3, 2026. This Interlocal may be extended at the discretion of the Parties through written amendment executed by the Parties.

B. Amendment. Section #3, of the Agreement titled “Tasks” , sub-section 3.2.2 is amended to read as follows:

3.2.2 The estimated cost to provide services is not to exceed \$100,000.00 with any additional charges being submitted to the SBAC for approval.

C. Effective Date. This First Amendment shall become effective upon execution by both Parties and filed with the Clerk of Court.

D. Original Agreement. Unless expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the Agreement shall be and remain in full force and effect. In the event any of the prior amendments to the Agreement conflict with this First Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
