Background:

Lutheran Services of Florida (LSF) serves as the Managing Entity for State Circuits 3 and 8. They receive funding from the Florida Department of Children and Families to support a range of behavioral health services. LSF distributes these funds to providers across the Circuits, including Alachua County. In Alachua County, this funding supports our Crisis Center Mobile Response Teams, 988 Crisis Line operations, the Mobile Integrated Healthcare team, and partially funds the Metamorphosis long-term residential substance abuse treatment program.
