Background:

The vendor has operated the Alachua County Employee Wellness since October 1, 2019, following a

competitive procure, Request for Proposal (RFP) 20-95. The First Amendment changed methods for purchasing computers and added language on giving Center Staff pay raises.

The Second Amendment memorializes the acquisition of Care Here Management by Premise Health Employee Solutions, LLC and extends the term through September 30, 2026 with one (1) additional two (2) year renewal remaining.

The Third Amendment updates the Scope of Services and Administrative Fees.

The Fourth Amendment updates the Scope of Services to include Supplemental Statement of Work, Exhibit A-2, adding Care Navigation Services.
