**Lutheran Services of Florida Amendment 103 Change in Funding for Mobile Response and 988 Crisis Line**

**Description:**

This amendment adds an additional \$4,054 to Crisis Mobile Response and reduces funding for the 988 Crisis Line by \$94,370.

**Recommended Action:**

Approve LSF agreement amendment, approve the resolution, budget amendment, and authorize the Chair to sign the contract.

**Prior Board Motions:**

Agreement was approved on August 11, 2025. Amendments have been submitted since then to extend the grant and adjust the budget amount.

**Background:**

Lutheran Services of Florida (LSF) serves as the Managing Entity for State Circuits 3 and 8. They receive funding from the Florida Department of Children and Families to support a range of behavioral health services. LSF distributes these funds to providers across the Circuits, including Alachua County. In Alachua County, this funding supports our Crisis Center Mobile Response Teams, 988 Crisis Line operations, the Mobile Integrated Healthcare team, and partially funds the Metamorphosis

long-term residential substance abuse treatment program.
