

Minimum Vendor Insurance Requirements

- Alachua County Risk Management Division sets insurance requirements generally based on the type of vendor and type of work. (level of risk).
- All of the types of vendors and the insurance requirements are on the Procurement Intranet Site for the Departments to use when setting up contracts and purchase orders. The Contracting Division of Procurement also knows what the insurance requirements are for different vendors.

When a Request for Proposal goes out the Insurance Requirements are also included.

Any vendor can call Risk Management to discuss these requirements and to ask for an exception to the requirements. Exceptions are granted based on the type of work being performed and the level of risk that is involved.
