Special Improvement District (SID) for Tara Larga Phase 1 and 2 Subdivisions

Description:

On October 25th, 2022 the Board of County Commission (BoCC) approved Ordinance No. 2022-16 for the purpose of establishing a process creating Municipal Services Benefit Units (MSBU) as a requirement of the acceptance of plats for future residential developments and to provide a funding mechanism for future road and capital maintenance and improvements within the MSBU. The Tara Larga Phase 1 and 2 subdivision is subject to the Ordinance.

Recommended Action:

The Board approve the Resolution to create a Special Improvement District for Tara Larga Phase 1 and Phase 2 and authorize the Chair to sign the Resolution

Prior Board Motions:

On October 26, 2021 the BoCC approved Consultant costs to start the necessary Ordinance, Resolution and Unified Land Development Code (ULDC) language to implement the SID program. On July 12th, 2022 the BoCC authorized staff to advertise a public hearing to adopt the Ordinance and ULDC language and adopted the ordinance on October 25, 2022.

Fiscal Note:

There is no fiscal impact with the creation of the district. Any fiscal impacts will be after the assessments are levied.

Background:

The Tara Larga Phase 1 and Phase 2 proposes a Final Development Plan for 101 single-family residential units with associated infrastructure improvements and open space. The Final Development Plan was approved by the Development Review Committee on March 28, 2024.
